**WorkCover WA is the government** agency responsible for regulating and administrating the workers' compensation scheme in Western Australia.

The scheme in Western Australia is designed to ensure workers who suffer a work-related injury or illness are compensated for lost earning, medical expenses, and other associated costs.

WorkCover WA regulates the scheme under the Worker's Compensation and Injury Management Act 1981 (the Act), with the primary objective to ensure work-related injuries are actively managed to assist injured workers to achieve a safe and sustained return to work.

## Role of WorkCover WA

- regulate and monitor service providers to ensure they comply with the Act
- provide information and education on all aspects of the scheme
- provide an independent dispute resolution service for workers' compensation issues
- monitor employers to ensure they maintain current workers' compensation insurance coverage for all
- ensure all workers employed in a prescribed noisy workplace have hearing tests
- manage processes related to workplace fatalities and assessment of permanent impairment claims.
