#### **Background**

WorkCover WA is the government agency responsible for overseeing the workers' compensation and injury management scheme in Western Australia.

This report is based on claims statistics from the WA workers' compensation scheme from 2019/20 to 2021/22. It provides a three-year average of industry benchmarks that can be used for evaluation of the occupational safety and health performance of organisations. WorkCover WA collects data from approved insurers and self-insurers about all workers' compensation claims lodged in the WA scheme. This includes data from all current and former approved insurers, self-insurers and the Insurance Commission of Western Australia as at 29 September 2023.

Claim statistics are lost-time claims resulting from work-related injuries/diseases (excludes asbestos, journey and disallowed claims). Industry classification is based on the *Australian and New Zealand Standard Industrial Classification (ANZSIC) 2006*, published by the Australian Bureau of Statistics. The ANZSIC system groups together businesses that carry out similar economic activities and is structured into a hierarchy of units reflecting different levels of description (available at abs.gov.au).

#### **Terms and definitions**

Claim costs	An estimate of costs for unfinalised claims, and the total cost of finalised claims attributed to the date in which a claim was lodged with an insurer.
Days lost	Number of days or shifts where the claimant is absent for work resulting from a work-related injury/disease, and is attributed to the date in which a claim was lodged with an insurer.
Frequency rate	The number of lodged claims per million hours worked. The number of hours worked is the total number of hours worked by workers covered by workers' compensation and hours are represented in millions. It is based on the number of hours worked by employed persons in Western Australia as supplied by the Australian Bureau of Statistics.
Incidence rate	The number of lodged claims per 100 workers. The number of lost time claims per hundred employees (part-time, full-time, casual, and seasonal) in Western Australia. It is based on employed persons in Western Australia as supplied by the Australian Bureau of Statistics.
Lost-time claims	Claims for which the injury or disease results in an absence from work of at least one day or shift.
