



## *Workers Compensation and Injury Management Act 2023*

### **General Practitioner Consultation Fees & Codes - 1 November 2025**

Medical practitioners attending to or treating workers compensation patients under the *Workers Compensation and Injury Management Act 2023* are required to charge for services in accordance with the [Workers Compensation \(Medical Services\) Fees Order 2025](#) (Fees Order), from 1 November 2025.

The Fees Order provides that the maximum fee or charge payable for a medical expense for a medical service is the amount specified in the *Australian Medical Association's List of Medical Services and Fees* (AMA Fees List), except for workers compensation ancillary services and diagnostic imaging services.

This schedule summarises common consultation codes and fees in the AMA Fees List that general practitioners are required to use for professional attendances with workers compensation patients.

For all other medical services, please refer to the current AMA Fees List (available to AMA members or by AMA subscription).

If a general practitioner is issuing a certificate of capacity the Fees Order requires the fee to be charged and billed as part of a time-based or content-based AMA Fees List consultation item.
